



NCYC 2021 (PRELIMINARY*) BILLING PLAN

"How much does it cost to attend NCYC 2021?" ~ Everyone

It's a simple question with a complicated answer. This sheet will explain how we charge what we charge.

What you charge your participants is up to you. In the spirit of fairness and good stewardship, groups will be billed for actual fair room usage for NCYC hotel rooms. The per person rate billed by OYYA will be lowered according to how many persons are assigned to a room.

NFCYM just announced hotel rates, taxes and fees. The actual room rate at the Courtyard by Marriott Downtown Indianapolis (the hotel we've been at for many years), after taxes & fees, amounts to \$193 per night (a slight decrease from past years). Staying 3 nights, it costs approximately \$579 per room. OYYA is making every effort to bill groups for actual costs.

This will no doubt be harder to calculate for group leaders, but is the most fair way to do it!

Here is the per-person rate+ that OYYA will bill you, along with a comparison to 2019 rates:

The figures above also include the NCYC diocesan package, which includes conference registration & materials, tshirts, a possible diocesan gathering with food (will need to be determined based on current plans from NFCYM and the hotels), and misc. administrative costs.

COVID Recommendation: Due to the nature of an ongoing global pandemic, the Office for Youth Ministry is recommending that parishes place 2 people per room (unless members of the same household, like parents and children) to reduce the possible spread of Covid. This is the safest way to keep social distance while in the hotel. We'd rather error on the side of being cautious and safe, though, and this is one way of doing this. Parish leaders can request more than two people in a room after consulting their parish priest and other decision makers. An example would be if all four teens are vaccinated or family members staying together. While the OYYA will not be checking for vaccine records, we are highly recommend anyone considering attending NCYC to be vaccinated.

Married couples may be placed together, as may any persons related to one another and/or from the same immediate family. Otherwise, we place adults (post-HS 18 and over) with adults, teens with teens.

As you can see, the financial incentive for group leaders is to fill rooms, and avoid singles. Group leaders wanting to avoid singles should work with other group leaders and OYYA on roommate requests. Group leaders will have the ability to request that they be roomed with unfamiliar roommates (participants from other groups). OYYA will make every effort to fulfill your requests.

OYYA DEFAULT ADULT HOTEL PLACEMENT: We will place adults no more than 2 to a room, unless you request differently. In the event of a single, we will assign a roommate from another group. Priests are assigned singles. Married couples are usually assigned to their own room.

OYYA DEFAULT YOUTH HOTEL PLACEMENT: We will attempt to place 2 same-sex teens together, and will assign roommates from another group (usually no more than two groups in one room), unless you request differently.

+Price increases: *In an attempt to encourage advanced registration, NFCYM is doing tiered pricing. I have to charge you what we are being charged. The rates above are for those participants you register on or before July 31st. For those registering during August, add \$10 per person. For those registering in September, add \$25. Those registering after September 30th, add \$40.*
